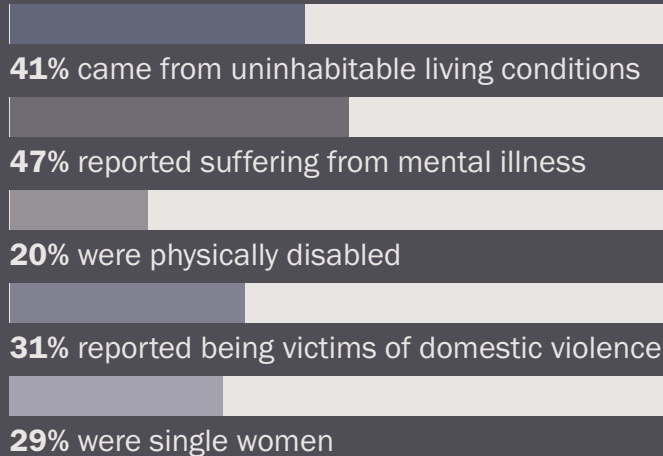

624

SHELTER & DIVERSION SERVICES

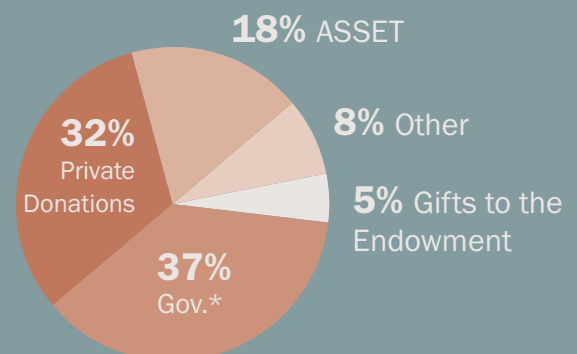
- **1,350** individuals served
- Nearly **70%** of clients who left shelter entered housing
- **96%** of those sheltered did not have to repeat their stay
- Due to a lack of resources, **302** people were turned away

COMMUNITY PARTNERS

Have a look at what we did last year:

- Local police assist our outreach staff, providing support and services to the homeless population.
- ASSET provided over **\$350,000** from the City of Ames, Story County, and United Way of Story County.
- Story County faith groups contributed **11%** (of private donations).
